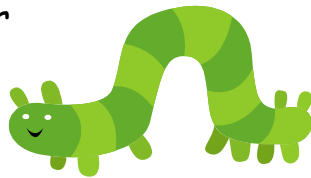


## Making a StorySack

A storysack is a 'goody bag' to use when reading. It contains the story book and a few things that will help to play out the story whilst you read and explore the themes in a fun way. Anyone can make a storysack: parents, families, teachers, groups of friends, just about anyone.

- You can make one on your own or do it as a group. Start with the story book:
- Look at the pictures and the story
- Make a puppet (a sock will do) for the main characters e.g. The Hungry Caterpillar



- Collect safe toys to help act out the story e.g. plastic food - no small parts that can be swallowed
- Buy or make a sack to keep everything in. You could put the title of the story on the bag, or use pictures to help identify the story e.g. a butterfly pattern



- Tell the story using your props to bring the story to life and make it fun, use silly voices when appropriate
